A Section Leader of the Dunedin Concert Band performs an administrative role that supports the individuals of their assigned section.

The most important duties are to:

- 1. Allocate parts to section members, in consultation with the Conductor
- 2. Fill open positions
- 3. Lead sectional rehearsals
- 4. Provide feedback from Performers to the Conductor
- 5. Keep section member (and own) egos in check
- 6. Maintain a healthy team spirit
- 7. Mentor and train section members to become future Section Leaders

To fulfill these duties, Section Leaders must:

- 8. Be musically qualified
- 9. Place more emphasis on the success of the band over their own self-promotion
- 10. Develop and harness the support of each section member
- 11. Understand the musical needs, social needs, and communication methods of each section member
- 12. Encourage enthusiastic recruitment from members
- 13. Be passionate, confident, and loyal
- 14. Be recognized as possessing leadership and/or relationship skills
- 15. Attend at least 90% of all scheduled sessions (rehearsals and performances) each calendar year.

Section leaders:

- 16. Will serve their section for 1, 3 or 5 years depending on the band's needs
- 17. May be reassigned only if there are no qualified applicants for the position
- 18. Should communicate with the Conductor regularly but avoid doing so immediately before, during and after rehearsals and performances, unless necessary.
